**Municipal Curbside Garbage Contracts**

Mel Langton and Revel Stewart were present to discuss the existing contract.

Proposals that the 2000 bags that are average for a two week period, currently takes eight (8) days but said they could cut it to six days but they would need to work 10 hour days. Concern over the length of days, and that some of it would have to be in darkness.

Councillor Trimm made some points of clarification.

Sold 54, 000 bags approximately  
 $49,920 \div 2910 \text{ stops} = 17 \text{ Bags per household}$   
< 33%  
 $\$108,472.26 = \$2.17 \text{ per bag pickup}$

Several comments were made about the concentration and satisfaction nature of the contract.

Deputy Mayor Lowe and Councillor Cobb stated their satisfaction of the contractor.

Mayor Rathwell commented on the Historical development of the current curbside garbage pick-up.

Councillor Labow made several points regarding the possible change to bi-weekly pick-up.
