- MOE Draft Certificate of Approval has been produced and we should be receiving it shortly
- MOE requires a notice to go in paper to announce service area change

Ross Site

- Application for Certificate of Approval went in fall 2001
- Jp2g stated that we begin negotiations with property owners Re: placing monitoring wells on their property
- Jp2g reviewed the change in the MOE Application Fee.
- Consensus was obtained from Committee that the Chair and Vice Chair and Jp2g representative will meet with property owners. Office will contact residents.

Cobden Site

- Certificate of Approval application was submitted in late 2001.
