**ONTARIO REGULATION : 459/02**  
**Safe Drinking Water Act S. O. 2002 CHAPTER 32**

Persons taking water from a fire hydrant for any reason , other than *fire* or *fire training*, must have permission from the C.A.O.or the Public Works Supervisor.

Public works *trained personnel only*, shall operate the hydrants to take water, for any reason other than fire .

Any container to be filled must have a vacuum break in the supply line to prevent back-siphonage.

Hydrants **will not** be used to fill any container of any description that will be or has been used for application of pesticides .
