**MONTHLY ACTIVITY:** May 2013  
Patching and grading has been ongoing throughout the month.  
Sweeping the streets, intersections has been completed in most areas.  
We have been cleaning out culvert ends from the beavers blocking them up.  
We have cleaned up two large trees that have fallen in different areas of the township from wind.  
½ load restrictions were lifted on May 21.  
No issues were reported from the earth quake.  
Major rain storm washed out edges of many roads, as well totally washed out Finchley Rd at a culvert and the road is closed. Staff have been busy trying to repair all major problem areas.  
Two truck drivers have been hired for a temporary position. Hugh Martin and Lindsay Broadhurst were the successful applicants.  
Magnesium Road and Hawthorne Road have been turned back to gravel due to its poor condition.  
Faught Road has been Surface Treated from Cornerview to the Pentecostal camp. Pleasant Valley is next to be completed.  
Gravel has been added to Calvin Road.  
Benches and garbage cans have be put out on the main street in Cobden.

**DEPARTMENT: Environmental Services**

**MONTHLY ACTIVITY: May 2013**

Plants:

The Department is slow getting sludge hauled to Mississippi Mills...awaiting our Hauler to process Insurance requirements. We are roughly two – three weeks behind in sludge disposal. Eganville was able to take one load.

Departmental staff attended a session on WHMIS this month.

The Cobden Sewage Plant had to By-Pass twice this month due to heavy rain fall. The second event lasted a few days. Infiltration of storm water into the sanitary system quadrupled the flows within 10 – 15 minutes during the very intense rainfall.

Waste:

The Spring Household Hazardous Waste Event went well. The Event collected roughly 5,700 Kg of Hazardous waste products. Working on developing an access road on top of the completed Stage I Trench to resume landfilling operations at the North West corner of the landfill perimeter.

The entrance gates at the Ross landfill site are going to be replaced. New posts will have to be installed.

Beaumen Waste Management has been purchased by Andrew Shouldice. Andrew is from Kanata and has been Beaumen's Accountant for 10 years. Also on-board is Gary McElwain, Business Development Specialist. The Department met with both this month for introductions.

The Department is considering possible set-up/container at the Ross Landfill for cardboard. It would offer an additional disposal option for residents.

**Reeves Renfrew County Report For the Month of May**

During May I attended four half day meetings and two full day meeting.

Often I am asked what Renfrew County Health Unit has to offer our residents. Please find attached a copy of what we have offered in the past and future.

In January to April 2013 Renfrew County received 60 severance applications compared to 66 received over the same period in 2012.

A 14 lot plan subdivision was draft approval in the Town of Petawawa.

An amendment No. 12 to the Town of Deep River's Official Plan was approved by the County.

Discussions with Canadian Pacific rail Lanark County and the Township of Papineau Cameron continue in earnest.

At the end of March all parties had signed the confidentiality agreement with CP Rail. The next scheduled meeting with CP and the partner municipalities is scheduled for June 12/2013. The focus moving forward will be addressing appraisals and survey costs.

The second year in a row and in partnership with Pontiac Tourist Association the Ottawa Valley Tourist Association coordinated Ontario's Highlands Pontiac Region Pontiac Pavilion. Along with participation from 14 tourism operators and communities from both sides of the Ottawa River the Pavilion show cased a variety of tourism experiences available throughout the region including Whitewater Rafting, hiking, nature viewing, recreational geology, festivals and events.

Warden Emon has recommended that the County of Renfrew appoint an acting warden each year to assist the Warden in attending ceremonial functions or events after each Inaugural meeting for Warden. The next month after the Inaugural meeting the Warden would appoint the assistant Warden for the year. This was passed by the County. In April Social Services Committee reported Mr. Jim Grieve, Assistant Deputy Minister for Early Learning Division. In May Mr. Grieve postponed his planned visit to June 6 and 7, as Social Services Chair I will be attending a lunch meeting with him on one of those days.
