WATER/SEWER BILLING

The third installment of the 2013 water/sewer billing is due September 30th, 2013. A total of \$150,597.92 was billed in water revenue and \$56,978.24 was billed in sewer revenue.

Attached is an Accounts Receivable Report as of September 25th, 2013. Our outstanding balance is high at this time but there is over \$14,000 invoiced to government agencies and boards and one large tipping fee account is to be paid within a few weeks.

MONTHLY ACTIVITY: September, 2013

Trenched and installed electrical conduit from the drilled well to the Beachburg Water Plant. Control panel upgrades included the ability to monitor the static water level within the drilled well...simply had to run the wire to the well.

Algae bloom in Muskrat Lake persuaded the closing of the Public Beach. MOE testing of the lake showed evidence of Blue-Green Algae (microcystin). Testing of the treated water from the Cobden Water Treatment Plant showed no signs of microcystin. M&R Feeds was the successful bidder for the installation of security fencing at the Beachburg Water Treatment Plant,

Barron Disposal Systems was the successful bidder for the removal of scrap metal from the Ross Landfill.

Valley Window & Door was the successful bidder for the installation of new windows and doors at the Cobden Wastewater Treatment Plant.

The Department has begun forwarding documentation, records, drawings, etc. to Ontario Clean Water Agency for the upcoming

Terex Excavator down from mid-August to latter part of September. Utilized Public Works loader occasionally, the Hitachi for a brief period and a rental excavator from Buchanan's Sand and Gravel.

Moved a large volume of sand this month at the Ross Landfill. Cover material for the fall and early winter. Will also use the ground up mulch from the brush pile. National Grinding in the last week of the month grinding the pile. Household Hazardous Waste Event for the Fall was held on the 14th. Good turn-out I understand.

Reeve's Report

Month of September 2013

During the month of September, I attended three half-day meetings and one full day.

County Council had a delegation from the Minister of Transport, Kingston Office, at our County Council meeting held September 25, 2013. They explained the work on highway 17, also had material on winter maintenance on provincial highways. I will give this material to the Public Works Manager at the October 2nd meeting. In 2013, MTO is investing approximately 14.6 million on highway improvements. In Renfrew County, I will also pass this material on where the work is done to our manager.

For the period January to August 2013, the County received 112 severance applications compared to 147 received over same period in 2012.

The Rural Ramble in the Ottawa Valley is now underway and the sites include: 11 Adventure & Explorations sites, 16 Agriculture & Food sites, 9 History & Heritage sites and 12 Arts & Culture sites. Sites are searchable by date and by theme as follows.

County Council passed a by-law at the September 25th, 2013 meeting approving an updated County of Renfrew Emergency Response Plan. I will present a copy to Whitewater Region CAO at the October 2nd meeting. A ten year Housing and Homelessness plan: This plan began in 2012 with a large range of stakeholders. The Housing and Homelessness plan examines the Housing issues and needs for residents of Renfrew County. The Plan has been sent to the Ministry of Municipal Affairs and Housing for review signed off by the County CAO, Director of Social Services and as Chair myself.

At the September 25th County Council meeting, the County staff by resolution directed to prepare the first draft of the 2014 County Budget using guideline of 1.5% increase over 2013 levy.

Renfrew County Economic Development held a summit at Renfrew September 26th, with guest speaker Mr. Rick Spense. Around 100 Mayors, Reeves, Planners, CAO's and Business people attended.
