Bills are now due on the last business day of every other month in *May, July, September, November, January and March*. Interest and penalty are charged on past due accounts. Due to the on-going pandemic, Council approved 0% interest and penalty for the months of March and April. Did you know the Township of Whitewater Region offers pre-authorized payment plans for Property Taxes and Water/Sewer Bills? Payments are taken from your bank account. There are many benefits:

- There are no cheques to write out
- No waiting in line
- You will save on postage and transportation
- You don't need to keep track of due dates
- No penalties for missing a due date.

Landfill Regular Operations

Regular business hours will resume on *Wednesday, May 20 and Saturday, May 23 from 8 a.m. to 2 p.m*. We ask that payment occur with exact cash amount, where possible. Electronic payment is also being explored but not available at this time.

Please use regular curbside collection for residential garbage and recycling.

PROPERTY TAXES

Please make note of the following upcoming due dates to avoid interest and penalty.

Final Tax Bill:	
First installment is due: August 31, 2020	
Second installment is due: October 30, 2020	

Interest and penalty for past due accounts are charged at a rate of 1.25%. Due to the on-going pandemic, Council approved 0% interest and penalty for the months of March and April. Please note that 19% of taxes you pay go to school boards, 30% to the County of Renfrew, and 10% for OPP policing.

Reminder!

Your first 2 bags of garbage placed at the curb can be any colour and do NOT need to be Whitewater Region yellow "W" bags. If you want to put more than 2 bags at the curb for pickup, you will need to purchase a yellow "W" bag for \$5. Thank you for reducing, reusing and recycling!
