- Grade 12 or equivalent with SWANA training and certification preferred.
- Previous related experience in the operation of landfill operations and equipment such as compactors, excavator, loader, and other miscellaneous equipment would be an asset.
- Knowledge in GPS equipment and underground locate equipment would be considered an asset.
- Strong interpersonal and communication skills and customer service experience.
- Ability to work independently including working remotely in the assigned corporate vehicle/ equipment utilizing work tools to ensure operations are conducted in an efficient, effective, and safe manner.
- Demonstrated excellent safety record, ability to meet physical demands of the position.
- Ability to be on call 24 hours per day combined with a flexibility in hours of work.
- Good interpersonal skills working in a team coupled with an ability to communicate effectively in both oral and written forms.
- Working conditions include exposure to physical hazards and inclement weather conditions such as blizzards, white-outs, ice storms, fog, etc.
