## **NOTICE OF PUBLIC MEETING TOWNSHIP AMENDMENTS TO THE COMPREHENSIVE ZONING BY-LAW**

The Council of The Corporation of the Township of Whitewater Region will hold a public meeting on Wednesday, September 18th, 2024, at 4:45 p.m., at the Whitewater Region Municipal Office, 44 Main Street, Cobden, Ontario, to consider a few amendments to the Comprehensive Zoning Bylaw, pursuant to Section 34 of the Planning Act, R.S.O. 1990, c.P.13.

The comprehensive Zoning By-law regulates lot sizes and how land may be used, where buildings and structures can be located on a property, the height of buildings, and parking requirements.

The Township is proposing to make the following changes to the Comprehensive Zoning By-law:

- Add the location of all Inactive Waste Disposal Sites to the Zoning Map.
- Add a site-specific zone for the Algonquin Trail and CN Rail Line. This Zone will permit an active recreational trail, defined as "land that provides access for snowmobiling and other off-road vehicle use, hiking, biking, walking, crosscountry skiing and any other outdoor recreation that requires the use of trails.'
- Amend an existing exception Zone, Tourism Commercial -Exception Seven (TC-E7) to allow a single detached dwelling to the list of permitted uses and require that a Site Plan Control Agreement is in place prior to future development on the property.
- Add a subsection to the Maximum Lot Coverage in the Agriculture zone. On an undersized agricultural lot used for residential purposes, the maximum lot coverage (how much of the land can be covered with buildings or structures) is proposed to be 20%. For agricultural and all other permitted uses, the maximum lot coverage is 2%.
