COMPREHENSIVE ZONING BY-LAW UPDATE

The Township of Whitewater Region is in the process of updating the Comprehensive Zoning By-law.

The Comprehensive Zoning By-law regulates the use of land on a site-level basis. Whitewater Region currently has four Zoning By-law documents in effect across the Township. The effect of the update will be to amalgamate the four documents into one Comprehensive Zoning By-law document for the community. The proposed By-law is available for review and comment on our website under Projects.

The Township hosted two Open Houses and one Statutory Public Meeting to gather feedback from community members on the proposed By-law. **A second Statutory Public Meeting will be conducted on Wednesday, September 20th, 2023 at 4:45pm at the Whitewater Region Municipal Office.**

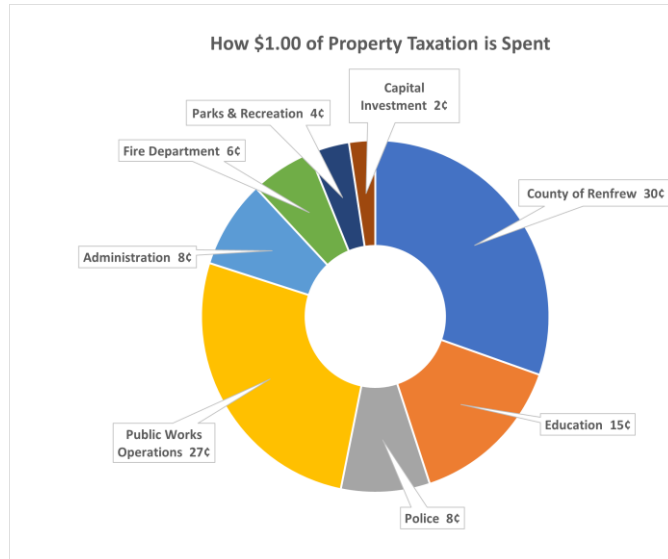

BURN PERMITS

Whitewater Region is currently under a partial burn ban for all open air burning except for recreational burns. For anyone who has a current open air or agricultural permit, or who is looking to register for one, the burn permit site will not allow you to proceed with your request while this burn ban is in effect.

Recreational burns must be reported for each campfire by calling the burn permit site at 1-855-922-2652 or online at www.burnpermits.com. Follow the safety guidelines as set forth by the Open-Air By-law # 20-06-1292, which can be found on the Township website under Fire Services.
