Dear Resident,

The Township and Jp2g had a kick-off meeting today with H&H Construction to review the proposed schedule and review the remaining scope of work.

Schedule Update

H&H will be returning mid-week and have provided that the remaining work will take approximately 5 weeks to complete.

The remaining work to be completed is as follows:

- Asphalt removal, new granulars and paving on Cameron Street from Earl Street to Vera Crescent
- Asphalt removal, new granulars and paving on Vera Crescent
- Concrete curb on Cameron Street and Vera Crescent
- Driveway tie-ins
- Landscaping
- Shouldering

Deficiencies

H&H construction will also be completing deficiencies during the same time frame within the completed area as shown in the map below.

Construction Location

The construction will take place within the Township's right-of-way but may result in some disruption to your private property. Lawns and driveways may be disturbed but will be reinstated at no cost to you. However, if you have any assets located within the Township's right-of-way that you want to preserve, we suggest that you relocate these items in advance of the construction work.

Access and Parking

The construction should not impede the access to your property but may provide some interruptions, such as when the contractor is installing curb in front of your home. In the event, that your driveway is not accessible, the contractor will provide notice to yourself 24 hours in advance.

During the construction, the Township asks that you do not park on the roadway unless your driveway is not accessible.

Garbage and Recycling

Curbside garbage and recycling collection will remain the same practice, but the contractor may bring bags and containers to a central location for pickup. Your containers will be returned to your property after collection. We ask that you mark your address on any cans or containers.
