BURN PERMITS



All owners who wish to set or maintain a fire in the Township of Whitewater Region must first obtain a permit. Permits are valid for the calendar year in which they are issued and expire December 31st of that year. Special/Agricultural burns require a site visit by the Fire Chief or designate for approval.

** All 2022 Burn Permits have expired ** ** No burning is permitted if a fire ban is in effect **

The Ross Landfill is located at 990 Kohlsmith Road. Hours of operation are:

Wednesday's & Saturday's 8am - 2pm.

All incoming vehicles must cross the scales to weigh in and weigh out. The maximum width of vehicles or trailers on the scale is 130 inches/3,302mm.

Proof of residency is required to access the landfill. Landfill fees are available on the Township website. Cash or Debit available

BEACHBURG DRINKING WATER SYSTEM (DWS)

The Beachburg Drinking Water System (DWS) is scheduled to be placed under precautionary boil water advisory starting at 11:30 pm on Wednesday, February 8th, 2023. The Ontario Clean Water Agency (OCWA) and the Township of Whitewater Region are working with the Renfrew County and District Health Unit (RCDHU) and Ministry of the Environment, Conservation and Parks (MECP) to complete necessary maintenance to the drinking water system.

New pressure tanks are being installed at the Beachburg Water Treatment Plant that will require the plant to be isolated from the distribution system which will result in a temporary loss of water and may cause a pressure loss throughout the system. Work will be completed early on February 9th, 2023 to limit disruptions to users.

Please refer to the Township's website for more information regarding precautionary boil water advisory. Residents will be alerted when the precautionary boil water advisory is lifted by the RCDHU, OCWA and the Township once the work is complete.

Pre-Authorized Payment Plans

Credit Card Online Payments

Now available by VISA, Mastercard or VISA Debit. See Website for link. Processing fees charged by Paymentus are applied on all transactions. Please allow a minimum of 3 business days for online payments for:

- Water/Sewer

Place your payments in the Drop Box located at the front door of the Municipal Office. If you require a receipt, please indicate that with your payment along with your email address or mailing address for the receipt to be sent to you.

Online Banking Payments

Payments for Property Taxes, Utility Bills and Accounts Receivable can be made at your bank or online. Please allow a minimum of 3 business days for online payments. For online banking, search payee:

Please note that for online banking, you will need to enter your roll #/account for each property separately with modifications.

- For tax payments, a 15-digit account is required. For water payments, an 11-digit account is required.

Please make note of the following due dates. Interest will be charged at a rate of 1.25% on current year's arrears. Penalty will be charged at a rate of 1.25% on previous years' arrears. If paying online or by credit card, please ensure payment is made at least 3 business days before the due date to avoid late fees.


