## Mayoral Decision MDE-2025-003

To provide direction for the preparation of the 2026 Budget

Under the Authority: Part VI.1 (Special Powers and Duties of Head of Council) of the Municipal Act, 2001, Section 284.6 (Organizational Structure).

The Mayor has decided as follows:

1. Direction to the CAO to prepare:

A summary of the draft 2026 Budget for Council and public consultation, considering:

- a 5-year Budget A 5-year Budget forecast addressing inflation, cost of living adjustments, maintaining levels of service, Asset Management Plan forecasted increases of 4.2% per year, OCIF/OMPF/CCBF allocations, OPP/County of Renfrew/Ministry of Education forecasted increases, and estimated annual assessment growth.
- a 5-year Capital Funding projection (excluding water and wastewater).
- a 5-year rate-supported Water and Wastewater Operating and Capital Budget, considering the 2025 10-year Water and Wastewater Rate Study.
- that assessment growth taxation revenues generated from new properties are included in the 2026 operating budget as growth.
- user fees and charges increasing in alignment with inflation, with subsidies supporting ratepayers only, and a contribution to capital reinvestment needs.
- the 2026 Budget considering feedback from the community, Council members, and direction from the Mayor, prior to the end of 2025.

## WHITEWATER -REGION -

- that proposed changes to the budget align with the overall objective of inflation plus capital infrastructure reinvestment, with a net tax requirement of no more than 7%, and not to exceed 3.4% of median household income (inclusive of County of Renfrew levy, OPP levy, and Ministry of Education levy).
