Place your payments in the Drop Box located at the front door of the Municipal Office. If you require a receipt, please indicate that with your payment along with your email address or mailing address for the receipt to be sent to you.

#### **Online Banking Payments**

Payments for Property Taxes, Utility Bills and Accounts Receivable can be made at your bank or online. For online banking, search payee:

## PEDESTRIAN CROSSOVERS ( PXO )

A pedestrian crossover is a designated crossing area that allows pedestrians to safely cross the road where vehicles must yield to the pedestrian.

Pedestrian crossovers are identified by specific pavement markings and crossing signs. At pedestrian crossovers, drivers including cyclists must stop and yield and, only when pedestrians have crossed and are safely on the sidewalk, can drivers and cyclists proceed. A crossover is different from a crosswalk as a crosswalk is usually found at an intersection with traffic signals or stop signs.

The Township currently has 7 pedestrian crossovers located in Beachburg, Cobden and Westmeath.



There are 4 types of PXO which are listed as type "A", "B", "C" or "D". The Township currently has type "C" and "D" pedestrian crossovers. The major difference between the two crossings is that a type "C" crossover has rectangular flashing beacons (RRFB) to warn motorists.
