Dear Resident,

Council and Township staff would like to thank you for your patience with the construction project.

Project Update

Thomas Cavanagh Construction Ltd. are continuing the rehabilitation of Olmstead-Jeffrey Lake Road and the following items are completed:

- Rock cut blasting/ removal
- Road realignments
- Steel beam guide rails
- Culvert replacements
- Acres Road realignment.

Double surface treatment (DST) application is approximately 70% completed on 5.2km of the total project length of 7.2km on Olmstead-Jeffrey Lake Road (See map below). The remaining 2.0km section that has not received DST is approximately from Acres Road to #562 Olmstead-Jeffrey Lake Road along with the 0.2km section of Acres Road. Due to current temperatures and warranty purposes, the remaining DST will be completed by the end of June 2022.

Remaining Work 2021


The remaining work that remains to be completed this year is as follows:

- Storm drainage works in the area of the 600 series of houses
- Lowering of a hydro service (by Hydro One)
- Asphalt driveway tie-ins
- Signage (by Township)

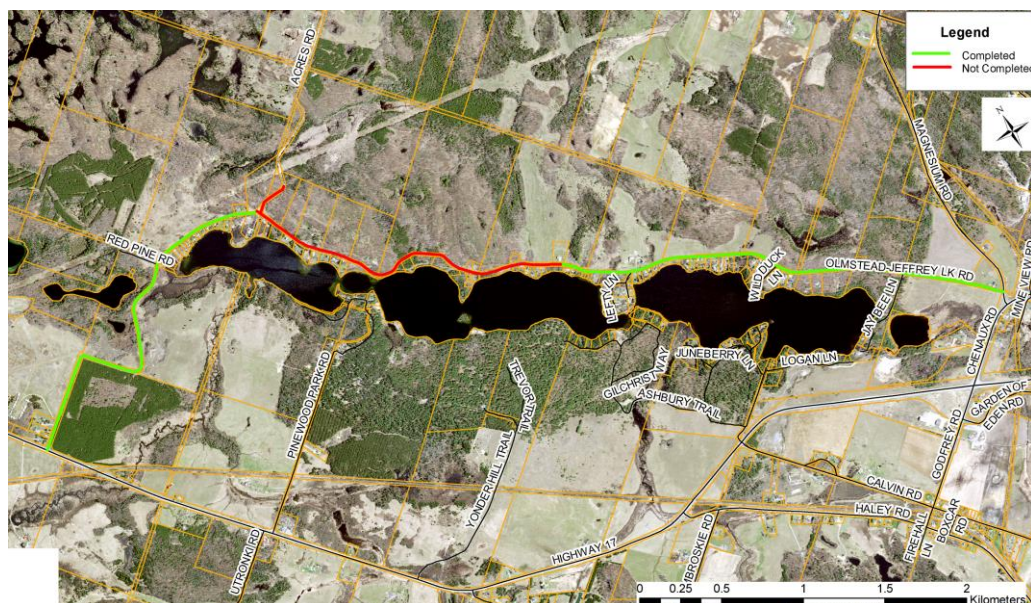

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- Remaining 2.0km of Double surface treatment (DST) on Olmstead-Jeffrey Lake Road
