Dear Resident,

The Township of Whitewater Region will be reconstructing Sturgeon Mountain Road in 2022. The project will be completed by Township staff and double surface treatment will be removed during the week of June 13<sup>th</sup>, weather depending. The construction will take place during the months of July and August with the hard surface completed this summer.

# **Project Description**

The project limits consist of Sturgeon Mountain Road from Beachburg Road (County Road 21) to Zion Line. The 1.05km rehabilitation project scope of work consists of the following:

- · Removal of double surface treatment
- Culvert replacement
- Minor ditching
- New granular base material
- Installation of a hard surface

### **Construction Location**

The construction will take place within the Township's right-of-way but may result in some disruption to your private property. Lawns and driveways may be disturbed but will be reinstated as soon as possible at no cost to you. However, if you have any assets located within the Township's right-of-way that you want to preserve, we suggest that you relocate these items in advance of the construction work.

#### **Road Closure and Traffic**

Traffic delays can be expected as lane closures and flagging operations may take place during construction. Road closures and detours are expected during the construction. Road closures will be communicated by email and on the project website <a href="www.whitewaterregion.ca/projects">www.whitewaterregion.ca/projects</a>. Road closure can also be viewed on Municipal 511 <a href="www.municipal511.ca">www.municipal511.ca</a>.

#### **Garbage and Recycling**

Curbside garbage and recycling collection will remain the same practice, but staff may bring bags and containers to a central location for pickup. Your containers will be returned to your property after collection. We ask that you mark your address on any cans or containers.
