Dear Resident,

The Township of Whitewater Region has started the rehabilitation of Zion Line. The rehabilitation project will take place over two years as the road will not receive a hard surface until 2023. This year's scope of work for the project is anticipated to be completed by June 13, 2022, depending on weather conditions.

Project Description

The project limits consist of Zion Line from Beachburg Road to Hila Road. The 3.2km rehabilitation project scope of work consists of the following:

2022

- Removal of double surface treatment
- Culvert replacement
- Ditching and drainage improvements
- New granular material

<u>2023</u>

• Installation of a hard surface

Construction Location

The construction will take place within the Township's right-of-way but may result in some disruption to your private property. Lawns and driveways may be disturbed but will be reinstated as soon as possible at no cost to you.

Road Closure and Traffic

Traffic delays can be expected as lane closures and flagging operations may take place during construction. Road closures and detours are expected during the construction. Road closures will be communicated by email and on the project website <u>www.whitewaterregion.ca/projects</u>. Road closure can also be viewed on Municipal 511 <u>www.municipal511.ca</u>.

Garbage and Recycling

Curbside garbage and recycling collection will remain the same practice, but staff may bring bags and containers to a central location for pickup. Your containers will be returned to your property after collection. We ask that you mark your address on any cans or containers.

Funding Source

The 2022 scope of work for the Zion Line rehabilitation project is being funded by Township's capital reinvestment reserve.
