PUBLIC NOTICE OF PESTICIDE USE

The Township of Whitewater Region will be using Wagar & Corput Weed Control Inc. to spray for noxious weeds along rural roadsides between July 1-31, 2025 (weather permitting). Spraying will follow regulations under the Pest Control Products Act and the Pesticides Act, specifically for areas near farmlands as per the Weed Control Act.

Pesticides to be used:

- ClearView Herbicide (Reg. #29752): Metsulfuron-Methyl & Aminopyralid
- Gateway Adjuvant (Reg. #31470): Paraffinic Oil & Non-ionic Surfactants

2025 PUBLIC WORKS PROJECTS

The reconstruction of Grants Settlement Road has been cancelled in 2025 due to staffing level changes in the Public Works Department. Council approved reallocating funds budgeted to rehabilitate Mine View Road from Magnesium Road (County Road 48) to Foresters Falls Road (County Road 7) with a total length of 8.9 km.

PUBLIC WORKS ENVIRONMENTAL

Curbside waste collection of garbage and recycling will shift forward by one day during the weeks of August 4th and September 1st, due to the Civic & Labor Day Holiday's.

Did you know that as of July 1st 2025, the management and delivery of the Blue Box collection program is changing? Circular Materials Ontario and their contractor Miller Waste Services will become fully responsible for the Blue Box program in Whitewater Region. Did you know that the Townships new Sewer-Use By-law requires that all downspouts be disconnected from the sanitary sewer by October 1st, 2025? Stormwater that enters the sanitary sewer can overwhelm the system and lead to sewer back-ups. Water from downspouts should be discharged to a permeable surface on your property for infiltration into the ground.

HOUSEHOLD HAZARDOUS WASTE DEPOT

Located at the Renfrew landfill - 376 Bruce Street. The Household Hazardous Waste (HHW) depot is open to all Whitewater Residents from May 3rd to August 30th for the disposal of hazardous waste.

Please note that there will not be a HHW Depot event day held in Whitewater in 2025. Please note the hours of operation at the Renfrew Landfill have changed since the publishing of HHW information in Whitewater's waste collection calendar. The new hours of operation are:
