

PAYMENT METHODS

Pre-Authorized Payment Plans

Did you know the Township of Whitewater Region offers pre-authorized payment plans for Property Taxes and Water/Sewer Bills?

There are many benefits:

- There are no cheques to write out.
- No waiting in line to make a payment.
- You will save on postage and transportation.
- You don't need to keep track of due dates.
- No penalties for missing a due date.

Credit Card Online Payments

Now available by VISA, Mastercard or VISA Debit. See website for link. Processing fees charged by Paymentus are applied on all transactions. Please allow a minimum of 3 business days for online payments for:

- Water/Sewer
- Property Tax
- Accounts Receivable

After Hours Drop Box

Place your payments in the Drop Box located at the front door of the Municipal Office. If you require a receipt, please indicate that with your payment along with your email address or mailing address for the receipt to be sent to you.

Online Banking Payments

Payments for Property Taxes, Utility Bills and Accounts Receivable can be made at your bank or online. For online banking, search payee:

Whitewater Region Taxes - Whitewater Region
Water - Whitewater Region AR

Please note that for online banking, you will need to enter your roll #/account for each property separately with modifications.

- For tax payments, a 15-digit account is required. For water payments, an 11-digit account is required.
- Example: Roll # 4758-051-045-21000.0000, enter the following

Taxes: 475805104521000,

Water: 05104521000

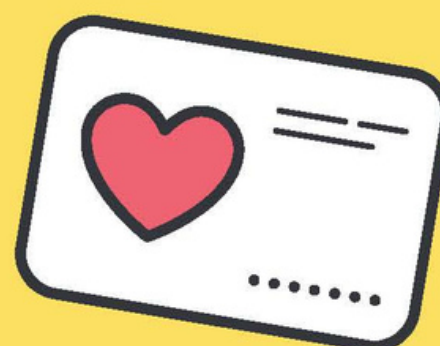

A person may keep up to 4 backyard chickens at a residential property which does not specifically permit a farm use, subject to obtaining a license. Conditions and requirements as set out in the by-law must be met. Roosters are not permitted. To obtain a permit, an application must be submitted with the \$150 fee and is subject to an inspection.

There is no sale of eggs, manure or other products associated with the keeping of hens. Chickens must be inside their coops or shelters from 9:00pm to 6:00am. No slaughtering on the property. The coop and any runs must be located within the rear yard and meet required setbacks. Maintenance standards must be adhered to. Fines of \$100 will be issued for non-compliance.

2022 ELECTION

The Township of Whitewater Region's municipal election will take place on
Monday, October 24, 2022.

Eligible individuals may consider running for one of the following offices:

Mayor - one elected at large

Deputy Mayor - one elected at large

Councillor - five elected at large

School Board Trustee

Monday, May 2, 2022 is the first day eligible individuals may file nomination forms for the offices of Mayor, Deputy Mayor, Councillors and School Board Trustee for the 2022 municipal elections. In addition, it is the first day to file a notice of registration as a third party advertiser. This must be done at the office of the Township of Whitewater Region (44 Main Street, Cobden) by appointment only. The deadline for candidates to submit nomination forms is Friday, August 19, 2022 at 2 pm.

INFORMATION FOR VOTERS

You need to be on the voter's list in order to vote in a municipal council or school board election. To find out if you are on the list to vote please visit
www.voterlookup.ca.

You can add yourself, confirm or update your personal information, change your school support for the purpose of elections and add other electors under your address.

You are required to show identification to vote. Identification must include name and address. Photo or signature is not required.
