BUILDING PERMITS

Performance Deposits have now been implemented for all new building permits to ensure applicants are finalizing and closing their building permits.

- Permits less than \$1,000 performance deposit \$300.00
- Permits greater than \$1,000 performance deposit \$1,500.00

The full amount of the deposit will be refunded once the project has passed final inspection within 24 months of the date the permit was issued. After that period, and without any further notice, the entire original deposit is retained for administrative purposes.

OUTDOOR FURNACES

A building permit is required for the installation of Solid Fuel Burning Appliances.

A site plan that includes distances from the outdoor furnace to any building located on the property must be included with the building permit application as well as the manufacturers specs.

Please contact the building department prior to filling out the application as Solid Fuel Burning Appliances are only allowed in certain zones of Whitewater Region.

The cost for the permit is \$125.00 plus a \$300.00 performance deposit. The performance deposit would be refunded once the final inspection has been completed within 24 months of the date the permit was issued.



BURN PERMITS

All owners who wish to set or maintain a fire in the Township of Whitewater Region must first obtain a permit. Permits are valid for the calendar year in which they are issued and expire December 31st of that year.

All burn permits issued in 2022 will be expired December 31, 2022.
