

## COMPREHENSIVE ZONING BY-LAW UPDATE NEW MEETING DATE

The Township of Whitewater Region is in the process of updating the Comprehensive Zoning By-law.

The Comprehensive Zoning By-law regulates the use of land on a site-level basis. Whitewater Region currently has four (4) Zoning By-law documents in effect across the Township. The effect of the update will be to amalgamate the four documents into one Comprehensive Zoning By-law document for the community. The proposed by-law is available for review and comment on our website under Projects.

The Township hosted two Open Houses and one Statutory Public Meeting to gather feedback from community members on the proposed by-law.

## HYDRANT FLUSHING NOTICE

The Ontario Clean Water Agency (OCWA) will begin the fall watermain flushing program. Flushing will take place between 7:30am to 3:00pm daily.

**BEACHBURG - OCTOBER 3rd to 6th, 2023**  
**COBDEN - OCTOBER 10th to 13th, 2023**

This semi annual maintenance program is designed to remove sediment accumulation within the watermains in order to maintain good water quality in the distribution system. This maintenance may result in temporary inconveniences including discolored water and lower than normal water pressure.

OCWA recommends avoiding water use when crews are flushing in your area. It is also recommended that users run a COLD water tap for a few minutes to clear any discolored water.

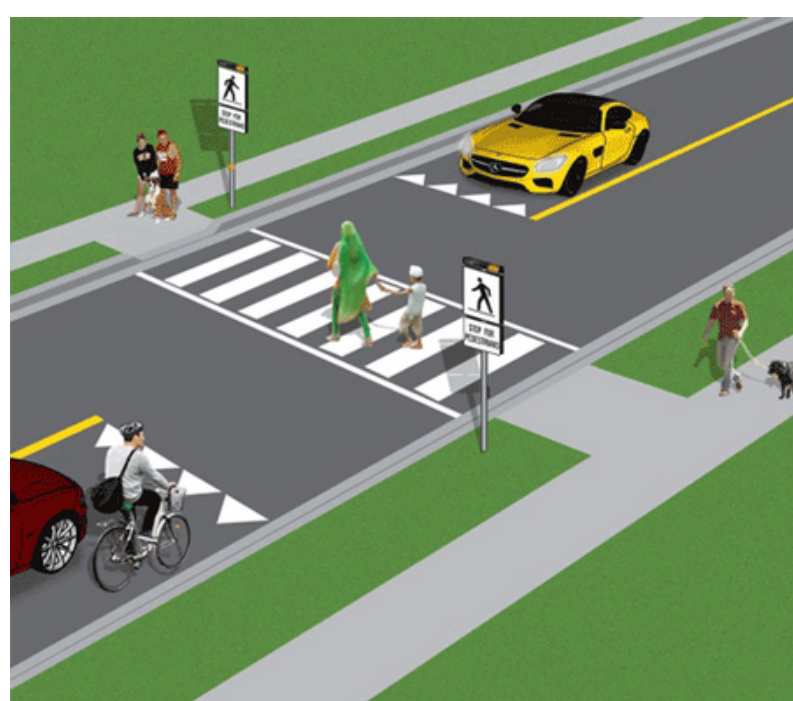

## PEDESTRIAN CROSSOVERS (PXO)



A pedestrian crossover is a designated crossing area that allows pedestrians to safely cross the road where vehicles must yield to the pedestrian.

Pedestrian crossovers are identified by specific pavement markings and crossing signs. At pedestrian crossovers, drivers including cyclists must stop and yield and, only when pedestrians have crossed and are safely on the sidewalk, can drivers and cyclists proceed. A crossover is different from a crosswalk as a crosswalk is usually found at an intersection with traffic signals or stop signs.

The Township currently has 7 pedestrian crossovers located in Beachburg, Cobden and Westmeath.
