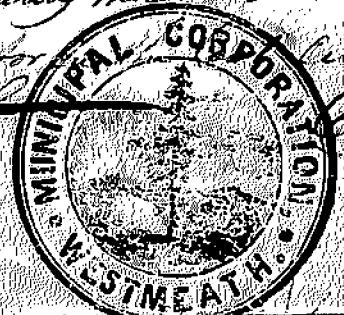


By Law to Alter and Amend the School Divisions now existing in the Township of Westmeath.

Whereas it is deemed expedient for the public benefit of the Township of Westmeath, that the present School Divisions of said Township should be altered and amended, so as their limits may be well known and accurately defined - Be it therefore enacted; and it is hereby enacted by the Municipality of the Township of Westmeath, constituted and assembled by virtue of and under the authority of an Act of the Parliament of Canada, made & passed in the 12th year of the Reign of Her Majesty Queen Victoria; and entitled an Act to provide by one general Law, for the erection of Municipal Corporations and the establishment and regulation of Police in and for the several Cities, Counties, Towns, Townships and Villages in Upper Canada; and acting under the authority of 13th & 14th Vic. Chap. 40, that the plan of the now existing school Divisions shall cease to exist on the 25th day of December, One thousand Eight hundred and fifty three, at which time a new territorial division hereafter to be made shall come into operation. All school contracts and matters relating thereto remaining valid for the present year as provided for in the said Act. Made & passed this Fifth day of June 1852
