Your Petitioners therefore pray that your Honourable Council may see fit and proper to grant us a separation from said section so that we may form a section of our own and have a school house built somewhere in a central part amongst us so that we can avail ourselves of the privilege of sending our children to school which we cannot do now and as is duty bound your Petitioners will ever pray
