

Whereas the Township Road Surveyors  
Reported to Municipal Council of the Town  
of Westmeath County of Renfrew that  
the Concession Line between the Sixth  
& Seventh Concession opposite Lot No 15  
South Half is impracticable for the public  
travel and Joseph Keyes having given  
Land for the road to cross his farm with  
any compensation being paid him for said  
Road

Be it therefore enacted by the Municipality  
of Westmeath Constituted and  
assembled by virtue of and under author-  
ity 22 Victoria Chapter 99

And it is hereby enacted by the aforesaid  
authority that Joseph Keyes be  
given so much of the Concession  
Line as lies opposite the Land  
which he has given for a road  
in compensation for the land which  
he has given for the Road commencing  
five Chains from the Post  
between 14 & 15 Running North 28 degrees  
west 5 Chains & 75 Links  
The Road is here by Established Com-  
mencing 2 Chains from aforesaid Post  
and following a Curved Line of  
Pickets 5 Chains & 75 Links and  
to be 40 feet wide from the fence  
as it now stands on East Side of  
said Road
