

By Law No 6

Whereas Samuel A. Huntington applied in writing to the Municipal Council of the Township of Westmeath to purchase the Sixth Concession Line from the turn of the road South of Mr Storres House up to Lot No 22 and Ira Mason petitioned the aforesaid Council to have the Sixth Concession Line opened up to Lot No 22 as closed it up stopped Egress to a certain part of his Farm and served the Council with a Petition signed by several of the Rate payers in the immediate Vicinity of the Road to have the aforesaid Sixth Concession Line opened for Public Travel

Be it therefore Enacted by the Municipal Corporation of the Township of Westmeath Constituted and assembled by virtue of and under Authority of the several Actes of Parliament and 22<sup>nd</sup> Victoria Chapter 99 Section 319

And it is hereby Enacted that the Sixth Concession Line be opened up from the turn of the road South of Mr Storres House to Lot No 22 for use and benefit of Public Travel and the Reeve is hereby empowered to have the obstructions and hindrances taken of the Road and the Sixth Concession Line to remain a Public High way
