Be it enacted by the municipality of Westmeath
Constituted and assembled by virtue of and
under authority of an act of parliament of
Canada made and passed in the 13 year of the
Reign of Her Majesty Queen Victoria and
entitled an act to provide by one general Law
for the erection of Municipal Corporations and
the establishment of regulations of police in and
for the several Cities Counties Towns, Townships,
and Belages in upper Canada,

And it is hereby enacted by authority of the same
