By Law to authorize the levying and collecting Township Tax

Be it enacted by the Municipal Corporation of Westmeath constituted and assembled by virtue of and under the several acts of Parliament and was ~~be~~ enacted by the authority aforesaid that one mill in the dollar be levied for County of Renfrew purposes four hundred and forty five dollars and 64 cents for County purposes two hundred and thirty dollars for School purposes four hundred and forty dollars for Township purposes Railroad Tax four hundred and thirty three dollars and five cents

Be it therefore enacted by the Municip-
al Council of the Township of Westman
by virtue of and under authority of an
act of Parliament of Canada
entitled an act respecting Municipal
institutions of Upper Canada and
it is hereby enacted by the authority
of the same that it shall be
lawful to Levy and Collect by
the Township Collector on all
Resident Rateable property the
Sum of Thirteen Hundred and
Sixty Three Dollars and 55 Cents
to cover Township Expenses County
Rate and Equivalent School Tax
and Fifteen Hundred and Fifty one
dollars Special School Tax
all to be collected by Township
Collector
