

Preamble

By Law No 1
To establish the Height of a Lawful
Fence in the Township of Westmeath
and appointing Township Officers
Be it Enacted by the Municipality of Westmeath
Constituted and assembled by virtue
of and under authority of an act of Parli-
ament of Canada made and passed in the
13th year of the Reign of Her Majesty Queen
Victoria and intituled An Act to provide
by one General Law for the erection
of Municipal Corporations and the estab-
lishment of Regulations of Police in and
for the several Cities, Counties, Towns,
Townships and Villages in Upper Canada
and 22nd Victoria Chapter 54 of the Consolida-
ted Statutes of Upper Canada

And it is hereby enacted by authority of the same
That the Height of a Lawful fence is
Five feet built of Logs and if built of Rails
to be staked at the corners

And that G. B. Tucker be Treasurer for Current
year

And that Nathaniel Wright be Township Clerk
for Current year

And that John Bennie and John
Griffiths be Auditors for 1863

And that James Duran George Cowder
Francis Patraut Rod Lu Dong
Joseph Keyes Peter Buchanan
Joseph Switzer
John Crawford John Wright
be fence assessors for Present year

And that Robert Mc Lellan be Road Surveyor
for Current Year

And that William Carrivick be and is
Tavern Inspector for present year
To wit, Carrivick Shreve
