By Law No 4 to establish a Road from  
2<sup>nd</sup> Con East of Muskbat Lake between Lots No 4 & 5  
to Muskbat Lake thence across Lots No 4, 3, 2, & 1 in  
the first Concession

Whereas A Number of Ratepayers of the Township  
of Westmeath applied by Petition to the Municipal  
Council to have a road established from 2<sup>nd</sup> Con  
E. M. L. between Lots 4 & 5 to Musk Bat Lake thence  
across Lots 4, 3, 2 & 1 to Town Line of Ross and  
Robert McAllen Township Road Surveyor filed  
his report of the Road

Be it therefore enacted by the Municipal  
Council of the Township of Westmeath  
Constituted and assembled by virtue of and  
under authority of the Municipal Laws  
of Upper Canada

And be it enacted that a road be opened  
up and become a Public high way Commencing  
at the 2<sup>nd</sup> Con E. M. L. between Lots 4 & 5 at  
a Monument on the Line and run on  
Side Line between Lots 4 & 5 to Musk Bat Lake  
thence Commencing at a Monument on the Line  
between 4 & 5 Seven Chains and forty seven  
Links from the banks of said Lake and  
Running South 10 degrees west Seven Chains  
and sixty five Links, thence South Thirty  
degrees East Seventeen Chains thence South  
Twenty degrees East Eighteen Chains  
thence South Twenty degrees west Eight Chains  
and seventy six links thence South Three  
Chains and sixty five Links thence South  
Thirty degrees East forty two Chains thence  
South forty five degrees East Ninety Chains  
to a Post planted on the Side Line



of Road thence South Ten degrees west  
Twenty six Chains and Sixty seven links to  
a Post Planted on the Town line between  
the Township of Westmeath and Ross  
Six Chains from the bank of said  
Muskat Lake be the same more or less  
the whole of the Road to be Forty feet  
wide through out
