ity of Westmeath

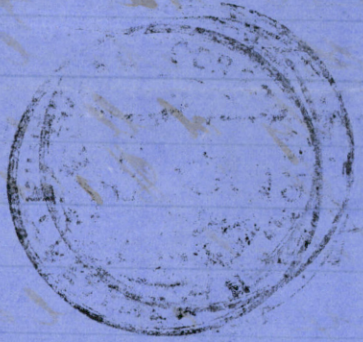
Therefore be it enacted by the Municipal
