

By-Law No. 2. 1864  
To Authorize the payment of Money.

Whereas it is expedient to pay out certain sums of money, herein-after mentioned, to defray debts of the Municipality of Westmeath.

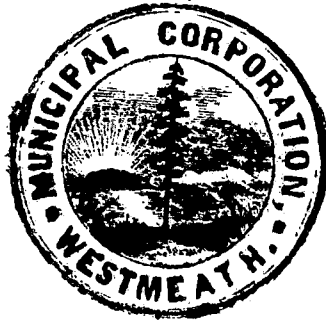
Therefore be it Enacted by the Municipality of Westmeath, constituted and assembled by virtue of and — under the Authority of an Act of Parliament of Canada entitled "An Act respecting the Municipal Institutions of Upper Canada."

- Sect<sup>n</sup> 1. And it is hereby enacted by authority of the same, that, Nathaniel Wright be paid the sum of Seventeen dollars, for a Map to the Council, and for two years collecting Tavern Licenses, years 1861 and 1862.
- " 2. And that James Poole be paid the sum of four and one half dollars, for Printing. And that The Commercial Bank,
- " 3. Perth, be paid the sum of three hundred and eighty-seven dollars, and forty-seven Cents, being balance due on Wheat and Flour.
