

By-Law No. 4. 1864

To fix the salaries and fees of the several Township Officers, and for other purposes therein mentioned,

Whereas it is expedient to fix the salaries and fees to be paid to the several Township Officers of the Township of Westmeath, and to enact that no orders shall be issued on the Treasurer unless upon detailed written statements

Therefore be it enacted by the Municipal Council of the Township of Westmeath, in the County of Renfrew, constituted and assembled by virtue of, and under the authority of an Act of ^{the} Parliament of Canada, entitled, "An Act respecting the Municipal Institutions of Upper Canada" and it is hereby enacted by and under the authority of the same that, the several sums of money, hereinafter mentioned shall be paid to the respective Township Officers for their several salaries and fees

- Section 1st. Be it enacted that the Township Treasurer shall be paid the sum of fifty dollars per annum for his services,
- " 2nd. that the Township Clerk shall be paid the sum of sixty-four dollars per annum
- " 3rd. that the Assessor shall be paid the sum of forty dollars for assessing ~~the~~ current year
- " 4th. that the Collector shall be paid the sum of forty-eight dollars for collecting ^{excepting School Rates} Rates levied for the present year.
- " 5th. that the Road Surveyor shall be paid the sum of one dollar and a quarter per day while employed.
- " 6th. that the Auditors shall each be paid the sum of one dollar and a half per day while employed.
- " 7th. that the Shop & Tavern Inspector shall be paid the sum of one dollar and a half for each Tavern inspected.
- " 8th. that the Librarian shall be paid the sum of ~~eight~~ ~~dollars per annum~~
- " 8th that the Clerk, for levying School Rates shall receive two per Cent of the amount.
- " 9th that the Collector for current year shall receive two and a half per Cent for collecting School Rates.

10th that the Reve be paid the sum of sixty dollars
for day while attending ^{to Township} ~~County~~ business out of
the Township for his extra trouble in attending to
Township business out of the Township.

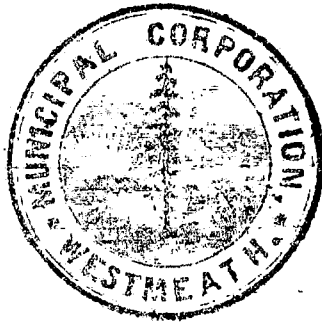
11 ~~12~~¹⁵ That no order shall be issued on the treasury on behalf
of any applicant, unless upon a Bill, Statement, or Demand,
made out in detail, and laid before the Council.

12 ~~13~~¹⁴ That on the receipt of any monies, the Treasurer
shall, either personally or by writing, report to the Council,
at its next sitting thereafter, the amount of such monies,
and the source whence received.
