

By-Law No. 1864.

To define the duties of the Inspector of Licenses for the Township of Westmeath.

Whereas it is expedient to define the duties to be performed by the Inspector of Licenses for the Township of Westmeath.

Therefore the Municipal Council of the Township of Westmeath, constituted and assembled by virtue of and under the authority of an Act of the Parliament of Canada, entitled, "An Act respecting the Municipal Institutions of Upper Canada" enacts as follows, and it is hereby enacted that the Inspector

sect- 1st. Of Licenses for the said Township shall, upon being furnished by the Township Clerk with the names and address of the parties applying for Tavern License within the limits of the said Township whose Petitions shall have been granted by the said Municipal Council, immediately thereafter proceed to inspect the premises of such parties, when, if he finds such parties qualified according to the By-Laws of the Municipality to keep such Tavern, and upon payment to him of the Municipal Duty thereon, and ^{the} delivery to him of the Bonds for the observance of the By-Laws of the Municipality, grant his Certificate to such parties for License for such Tavern.

" 2nd. That he shall upon being applied to by parties desirous of Chop License within the said Township, and upon payment to him, by such parties, of the Municipal Duty thereon, and the delivery to him of Bonds for the due observance of the By-Laws of the Municipality grant his ^{certificates} Licenses to such applicants.

" 3rd. That before granting ^{certificates} Licenses to keepers of Saloons or of Victualing Houses he shall await the advice and sanction of the Municipal Council thereon.

Sect. 4th. That he shall pay over to the Township Treasurer all monies received by him for ^{Certificates} Licenses within one month _____ after the receipt by him of the same, whose acknowledgement shall be considered a sufficient discharge for the said monies.

5th. And that he shall upon complaint, or information under Oath, of any person resident within the said Municipality, prosecute to conviction all parties selling spiritous, or fermented, or manufactured Liquors without license within said Municipality.
