

By-Law No 7. 1864

To amend the By-Law No. 3. 1864. entitled, a By-Law Respecting the issuing of Licenses to Taverns and ~~Shops~~ within the Township of Westmeath, in the County of Renfrew, and to regulate the same.


Whereas it is necessary to amend the said By-Law No. 3. 1864. passed by the Municipal Council of the Township of Westmeath on the twelfth day of March last past.

Therefore the Municipal Council of the Township of Westmeath, constituted and assembled by virtue of and under the authority of an Act of the Parliament of Canada, entitled, An Act Respecting the Municipal Institutions of Upper Canada, and it is hereby enacted by Authority of the same, that the fourteenth sub-section of the seventh section of the said By-Law No. 3. 1864 be, and is hereby repealed, and that the following sections be, and are hereby declared to form part of the aforesaid By-Law No. 3. 1864; And be it enacted that every Tavern Keeper Shopkeeper Saloon Keeper or any other person whatsoever who shall be duly convicted before the Reeve of the said Township, or any of Her Majesty's Justices of the Peace, for the United Counties of Lanark and Renfrew, for the vending or selling of Spirituous or fermented, or manufactured Liquors without license within this said Township, shall pay for the first offence a penalty of twenty dollars, and a penalty of forty dollars for every subsequent offence, one half of the penalty to go to the informer and the other half to the Municipality.

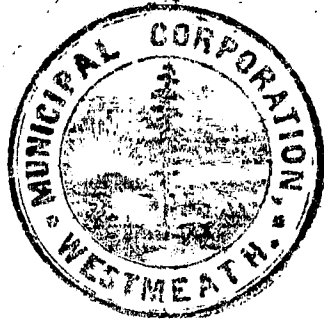
2nd that the sections 1st 2nd 3rd and sub sections 4th, 5th, 6th, 7th, 8th, 9th and 10th of the 7th section of the said By-Law shall apply, to the Keepers of Saloons within the said Township.


3rd And that all By-Laws or parts of By-Laws ^{relative} passed by the Municipal Council of the Township of Westmeath previous to the passing of the said By-Law No. 3. 1864. be and are hereby ^{to the issuing of Licenses} repealed.
