

By Law No. 7-1864

To Authorize the payment of money
Whereas it is expedient to pay out certain sums of
money hereinafter mentioned to defray debts of the
municipality of Westmeath.

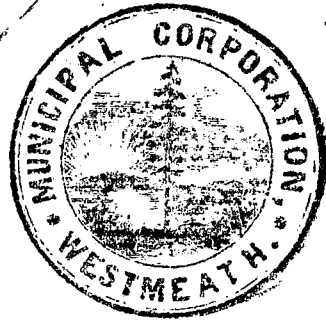
Therefore the Municipal Council of the Township
of Westmeath, Constituted and assembled by virtue of
and under the authority of an Act of Parliament of
Canada, entitled, "An Act respecting the Municipal
Institutions of Upper Canada, and be it enacted
by authority of the same that, One \$900 Dollars
be paid for Postage to March 31st 1864, also -
One Dollar be paid the Inspector of Town
Licences for the year 1863.

And that Joseph Hayes be paid forty-three dollars and
 $\frac{58\frac{1}{2}}{100}$ for Collecting School Rates for '63. Forty-eight dollars
for Collecting Township Taxes for 1863, and forty
dollars for Assessing the Township for 1864.
