

By-Law No. 10 - 1864.

To divide Road Division No. 13 of the Township of Westmeath into two divisions, and to appoint a Pattenmaster to the new divisions,

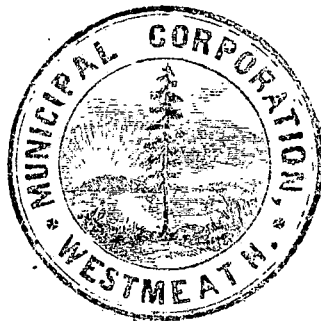
Whereas it is expedient to grant the prayer of the Inhabitants of the 13th road division and to divide the said 13th road division into two divisions and to appoint a Pattenmaster for the new road divisions,

Therefore the Municipal Council of the Township of Westmeath, constituted and assembled by virtue of and under the authority of an Act of the Parliament of Canada, entitled, "An Act respecting the Municipal Institutions of Upper Canada" enacts as follows, that, the said 13th Road Division be, and is hereby divided at the line between Lots, numbers 9 and 10 in the 4th and 5th Concessions of the said Township, that part of the division numbering from No 10 upwards to retain the name of the 13th Road division, and from no. 9 numbering downwards, (both Lots being included) to be termed the 15th Road division in said Township. And that Abel Beach is and is hereby appointed Pattenmaster to the 15th Road Division, for the present year.
