

By-Law No. 12. 1864.

A. By-Law more effectually to prevent the sale of Liquors without License, within the Township of Westmeath —

Whereas, it is necessary to prevent the sale by retail of Spiritous, fermented, or manufactured Liquors, within the limits of the Township of Westmeath, without License,

Therefore, be it enacted by the Municipal Council of the Township of Westmeath, constituted and assembled by virtue of and under the authority of an Act of the Parliament of Canada, entitled, "An Act respecting the Municipal Institutions of Upper Canada"; and it is hereby enacted by and under the authority of the same that, any, and every person or persons whomsoever, who shall be convicted before any two of Her Majesty's Justices of the Peace within the said Township of Westmeath, of selling or permitting to be sold, in, or on, his or her House or Premises, by retail, any spiritous, fermented, or other manufactured Liquors without License, within the limits of the said Township of Westmeath, shall

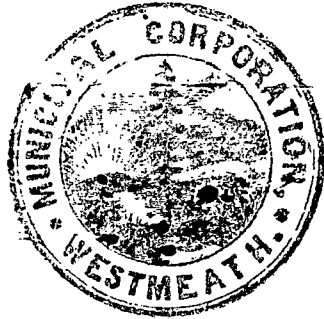
sect. 1st. pay for the first offence a penalty of not less than five dollars nor more than twenty dollars, with costs; for the second offence a penalty of not less than ten dollars nor more than thirty dollars, with costs; and for the third and every subsequent offence a penalty of not less than twenty dollars nor more than forty dollars, with costs, which said penalty, or penalties and costs if not forthwith paid to the Justices, shall be recovered from, and levied by distress against the goods and chattels of the person or persons who are the proprietors in occupancy, or tenants or agents in occupancy, of said House or Premises, and who shall have been found by himself or herself or themselves or his, her or their servants or agents, to have sold such Liquor or Liquors as afore-

said without License within the said Township, and if no distress be found out of which said penalty and costs can be levied, then the said above mentioned person or persons shall be imprisoned with or without hard labour (at the discretion of the Justices,) in the Common Gaol at Perth, in the United Counties of Lanark and Renfrew for any period not less than twenty-one days nor more than sixty days-

Sect. 2nd. And that all By-Laws or parts of By-Laws relating to penalties for the sale of Liquors within said Township without License, which are contrary to the intent of this By-Law, and which have been passed by the said Council previous to this day are hereby repealed.
