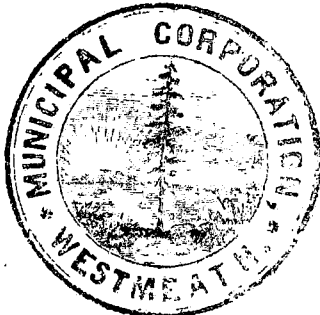


By-Law No. 13. 1864

A By-Law to pay out certain monies therein mentioned  
Whereas it is expedient to pay out certain sums of  
money herein mentioned,

Therefore be it enacted by the Municipal Council of  
the Township of Westmeath constituted and assembled by  
virtue of and under the authority of an Act of the Par-  
liament of Canada, entitled, "An Act respecting the  
Municipal Institutions of Upper Canada," and it is  
hereby enacted by and under the Authority of the same  
that, Messrs W. C. Chesworth & Co of Toronto, be paid the  
sum of seventeen dollars and ninety-three cents, for  
Polls, Books, & <sup>that</sup> ~~to~~ <sup>the</sup> Trustees of School Section  
No four be paid the sum of three dollars, as in  
and to be used in non-resident Lands in said  
Section for the year 1863. and that Newton Eglington  
be paid the sum of thirteen dollars and ten cents for window  
blinds, and costs of Prosecutions of unlicensed ~~carriage~~ <sup>cars</sup>.
