

By-Law No. 14 - 1864

A By-Law to authorize the payment of certain sums of money therein mentioned.

Whereas it is necessary to pay the several sums of money herein-mentioned,

Therefore be it enacted by the Municipal Council of the Township of Westmeath, constituted and assembled by virtue of and under the authority of an Act of the Parliament of Canada, entitled, "An Act respecting the Municipal Institutions of Upper Canada", and it is hereby enacted by virtue of and under the authority of the same, that, James Gill be paid the sum of ten dollars and twenty-three cents, being his fees as Constable in the prosecutions of persons selling spiritous Liquors without License, and Newton Eggleston the sum of eleven dollars and forty-five cents for detections made upon persons selling spirits unlicensed.
