

By-Law No. 15 - 1864

A By-Law to Levy and Collect certain monies therein mentioned.

Whereas it is necessary to Levy and collect on the rateable property of the Township of Westmeath, the following several sums of money, viz: the sum of two hundred and thirty dollars for General School purposes, the sum of four hundred and forty-seven dollars and eighty-seven cents for the United Counties of Lanark and Renfrew, the sum of seven hundred and sixteen dollars and sixty cents for the County of Renfrew, the sum of four hundred and eighteen dollars and eighty cents for Execution Rate for the Provincial Government against the United Counties of Lanark and Renfrew in respect to Loan Fund Debentures, and the sum of five hundred and ~~four~~<sup>thirteen</sup> dollars and fifty cents for Township purposes.

Therefore be it enacted by the Municipal Council of the Township of Westmeath, constituted and assembled by virtue of and under the authority of an Act of the Parliament of Canada, entitled, "An Act respecting the Municipal Institutions of Upper Canada," and it is hereby enacted by and under the authority of the same, that there shall be Levied, and collected by the Township Collector for the present year, the undermentioned Rates upon all the rateable property within the said Township of Westmeath, To Wit: A Rate of one mill  $\frac{56}{100}$  in the dollar for
