

By-Law No. 18 - 1864 -

A By-Law to authorize the payment of certain sums of money therein mentioned.

Whereas it is necessary to pay the several sums of money hereinafter mentioned,

Therefore, be it enacted by the Municipal Council of the Township of Westmeath, constituted and assembled by virtue of and under the authority of an Act of the Parliament of Canada, entitled, "An Act respecting the Municipal Institutions of Upper Canada", and it is hereby enacted by virtue of and under the authority of the same, that, J. M. Carswell be paid the sum of twenty-five dollars, for expenses, Mr. William Moore be paid the sum eight dollars, for mending bridge on the road to Mr. Fraser's Mills, that *Patrick Mulloy be paid the sum of seven ⁵/₁₀₀ dollars, that *Wynnan Olvested be paid the sum of eight dollars and twenty Cents (License expenses) and that Robert Graham be paid the sum of twelve dollars, for attending bridge on Musk rat, and that the sum of one and a half dollars be paid to Joseph Howard for repairs on scraper belonging to the Corporation.
