

By Law No. 20 - 1864.

A By-Law to authorize the payment of certain sums of money therein mentioned. Whereas it is necessary to pay the several sums of money herein after mentioned. Wherefore the Municipal Council of the Township of Westmeath, constituted and assembled by virtue of and under the authority of an Act of the Parliament of Canada, entitled, "An Act respecting the Municipal Institutions of Upper Canada", enacts as follows, viz.: - That, School Section No. 1. be paid the sum of one hundred S.S. 1. and fifty-five  $\frac{6}{100}$  dollars. School Section No. 2. the sum S.S. 2. of two hundred and thirty  $\frac{19}{100}$  dollars. School Section S.S. 3. No. 3. the sum of two hundred and fifteen  $\frac{48}{100}$  dollars. S.S. 5. School Section No. 5. the sum of two hundred and twenty-four  $\frac{7}{100}$  dollars. S.S. 6. School Section No. 6. the sum of one hundred and forty-eight  $\frac{1}{100}$  dollars. School Section No. S.S. 7. <sup>the sum of</sup> two hundred and forty-five  $\frac{10}{100}$  dollars. School Section S.S. 8. No. 8. the sum of one hundred  $\frac{16}{100}$  dollars. School Section S.S. 9. No. 9. the sum of one hundred and sixty dollars. S.S. 10. School Section No. 10. the sum of one hundred and five  $\frac{14}{100}$  dollars. School Section No. 11. the sum of eighty  $\frac{6}{100}$  dollars.
