As the new law requires the County Treasurer to furnish Municipal Clerk with list of all lands liable to be sold for arrears of taxes in the month of January, - (not having your Roll to include the taxes of '63 I could not send you the list so that you seem to have lost the Collection of these arrears for a year by your neglect in putting me in possession of the Non Resident Taxes.


