be more Effectually performed and
much better accommodate both sections

Your Petitioners therefore humbly pray
that your Honourable Body will
in their wisdom and liberality
be pleased to make the dividing
line between Pot's Hill and ten the
Circuit between the two newly made
sections, leaving the Government
Road in the fourth Concession in
that part of the section belonging to
the Village, and also appoint an
other Path Master to the Village part,
and as in duty bound your petitioners
will ever pray
