

By-Law No. 1. 1865.

A. By-Law to authorize the payment of certain sums of money therein mentioned.

Whereas it is necessary to pay the several sums of money hereinafter mentioned,

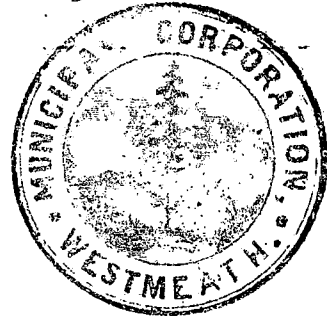
Therefore, be it enacted by the Municipal Council of the Township of Westmeath, constituted and assembled by virtue of and under the authority of an Act of the Parliament of Canada, entitled, "An Act respecting the Municipal Institutions of Upper Canada," and it is hereby enacted by and under the authority of the same,

that George Neilson be paid the sum of twenty-five dollars for printing for 1864. that Robert Mc Lelland be paid the sum of sixteen $\frac{25}{100}$ dollars for road surveying for 1864. that D. Chamberlain be paid the sum of fifty dollars as Treasurer for 1864. that Robert Thompson be paid the sum of six dollars for mending Bridges between Pembroke and Westmeath downwards, N. Wright the sum of eight dollars. † A. Archerson two dollars.
