

By-Law No. 2 — 1865

A By-Law to pay out certain sums of money therein mentioned.

Whereas, it is necessary to pay out the several sums of money hereinafter mentioned, and for the purposes mentioned,

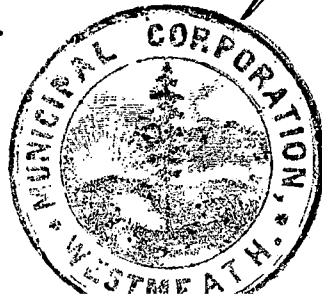
Therefore, be it enacted by the Municipal Council of the Township of Westmeath, constituted and assembled by virtue of and under the authority of an Act of the Parliament of Canada, entitled, "An Act respecting the Municipal Institutions of Upper Canada"; and it is hereby enacted by virtue and under the authority of the same that, the Trustees of School Section No. four, of the said Township, be paid the sum of three $\frac{54}{100}$ dollars, being for absence taxes in said Section for the year 1864, that the sum of two $\frac{40}{100}$ dollars be paid to George Tucker for postage and stationery for the year 1863,
