

By-Law No. 3 - 1865.

A By-Law to confirm the appointment of Township Officers for the Township of Westmeath.

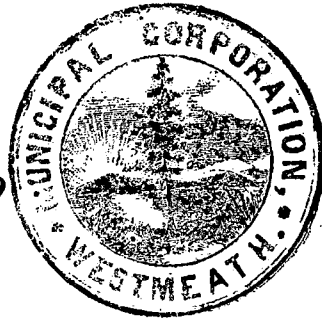
