

By-Law No. 5, 1865

A By-Law to pay out certain sums of money therein mentioned.

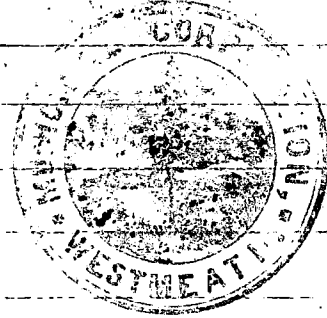
Whereas it is necessary to pay out the several sums of money herein under mentioned, Therefore the Municipal Council of the Township of Westmeath constituted and assembled by virtue of and under the authority of an Act of the Parliament of Canada, entitled, "an Act respecting the Municipal Institutions of Upper Canada", enacts as follows; and it is hereby enacted, by virtue, and under the authority of the said Act, that the Township Treasurer be paid the sum of thirteen $\frac{20}{100}$ dollars, for discount on Silver, ~~and~~ that Dr Purvis be paid in his Taxes for the present year, the sum of five $\frac{90}{100}$ dollars, and that the sum of four dollars be paid to the Pathmaster, John Robertson being the amount of Statute Labour paid by James and Hugh Brady for the year 1864.


