

By-Law No. 7-1865.

A By-Law to open up the allowance of road between Lots, numbers, five and six, in the second Concession fronting on Coulouge Lake, in the Township of Westmeath, in the County of Renfrew, and thence to the Coulouge Lake.

Whereas application has been made for the opening up of the allowance of road between Lots, numbers, five and six, in the second Concession fronting on Coulouge Lake, in the Township of Westmeath, and thence to the Coulouge Lake; and Whereas the parties resident on the line of the said allowance of road, have been duly notified of the intention to open up the said allowance of road, and as it is expedient that the said road be opened up for the ingress and egress of the inhabitants and others,

Therefore the Municipal Council of the Township of Westmeath, constituted and assembled by virtue of and under the authority of an Act of the Parliament of Canada, entitled, "An Act respecting the Municipal Institutions of Upper Canada", enacts as follows; and it is hereby enacted by virtue of and under the authority of the above cited Act, that ~~James Brownley, Moise Dupuis & George Melancon~~, all Fences or other obstructions which may be upon the aforesaid road, be removed therefrom, at the latest, one month from the passing of this By-Law and that the parties concerned be notified to that effect.
