


By-Law No. 8 - 1865

A By-Law to pay certain sums of money therein mentioned.  
Whereas it is necessary to pay the several sums of money hereinafter mentioned,

Therefore be it enacted by the Municipal Council of the Township of Westmeath, Constituted and assembled by virtue of and under the Authority of an Act of the Parliament of Canada, entitled, "An Act respecting the Municipal Institutions of Upper Canada," and it is hereby enacted by virtue of and under the authority of the same, that,  
S. J. A. Evans be paid the sum of twenty  $\frac{50}{100}$  dollars for Surveying a Road, W. Cannon be paid the sum of two  $\frac{45}{100}$  dollars for postage to date, and that Robert Graham be paid the sum of thirty-two dollars for attending bridge on the Muskrat Lake, and to P. J. Marshall ten dollars for expenses.
