

By-Law No. 10. 1865

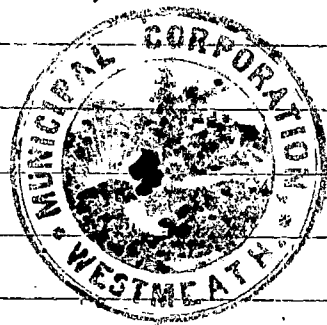
A By-Law to authorize the payment of certain sums of money therein mentioned.

Whereas it is necessary to pay the undermentioned sum of money, and whereas it was expedient to grant Orders, on the twenty-eighth day of October last, to Matthew McLaren for the sum of twelve dollars for work on Bridges on Government Road and to Patrick Mcarty for the sum of ten dollars for work on Proof line between Lots 15 + 16 in the ninth Concession, and whereas it is necessary to pay the several sums hereinafter mentioned,

Therefore be it enacted by the Municipal Council of the Township of Westmeath, constituted and assembled by virtue of and under the authority of an Act of the Parliament of Canada, entitled, "An Act respecting the Municipal Institutions of Upper Canada", and it is hereby enacted by virtue of and under the said authority aforesaid, that Matthew McLaren be paid the sum of twelve dollars, Patrick Mcarty the sum of ten dollars, and Newton Eggleston the sum of eight dollars, for expenses in Spotswoods Case and repairs on Townhall.
